A meeting of the Council was held in the Village Hall on Wednesday March 9th at 8 pm.

Those present were Chairman Mr Sutton Mr + Mrs Longmate Mr G Reynolds Mr Sands and Mr Luch. The minutes of the last meeting were read and signed.

Arising from the minutes on the reply from Mr Harrison Mrs Longmate proposed that all replies be brought to the meetings. This was seconded by Mr Luch and carried unanimously. A letter from the County Council was read asking if the Village Hall could be used in future for elections. As Trustees the Council felt it could be a reply to be sent to that effect.

An application by Mr Harrison for more caravans on the Camp Site was considered. A letter was compiled protesting against any increase.

A request by the Church Council for the Parish Council to repair the Churchyard Wall as written in the Times was discussed. It was proposed that the Parish Council Association be asked the permission. A complaint was made of cars being left in Bangray lane. It was proposed that a letter be sent to Mrs Jewell asking her sons not to leave them

in the roadway.

Mrs Longmate proposed that W.D.C. be asked if Sliffby was still on the list of priority for Sewerage. This was seconded by Mr Luch and carried. The Chairman said Two Ton Fifteen Cwt of coal had been given to pensioners at Xmas and £4.14 was still owing of which Councillors paid 13/6 each. The next meeting was fixed for Wednesday May 4th at 8 pm. The Annual meeting first to be followed by a council meeting

A meeting of the Council was held in the Village Hall on Wednesday May 4th at 8 pm.

Those present were Chairman Mr Sutton Mr Crafer Mr + Mrs Longmate Mr Sands and Mr Luch.

Mrs Longmate proposed Mr Crafer as Chairman seconded by Mr Sutton. Mr Sutton proposed Mr Luch as Vice Chairman seconded by Mrs Longmate both were carried.

A vote of Thanks to Mr Sutton the retiring Chairman was proposed by Mrs Longmate seconded by Mr Luch and carried.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and signed.

Arising from the Minutes re Churchyard Wall it was proposed that a copy of the Letter be sent to the Association of Parish Councils.

A reply from Mr Kemison on a Sewerage Scheme for the village was read. Mr Longmate explained the present programme of the R.D.C. and considered it would be 2½ to 3 years before it was in Stiffley.

A proposal to auction the school as a dwelling house was discussed. It was proposed that a letter be sent to Mr Kemison stating that the village was badly in need of a Village Hall and opposing the application.

A letter re Right of Ways was read. It was proposed the Council apply to have the Right of Way re-opened from Danson Lane through Sheep Wall and Big Hill. Also one at the White Bridges to the Sluices. The matter of Common Land was held over until a latter date.

A Precept for £10 was signed. The meeting ended at 9.15 p.m.

A Meeting of the Council was held in the Village Hall on Wednesday July 27th at 8 p.m.

Those present were Mr Crafer Chairman, Mr & Mrs Longmate, Mr G. Reynolds, Mr Sands, Mr Sutton and Mr Luch. The minutes of the last meeting were read and signed.

Arising from the minutes re Churchyard Wall as the Council were not bound by the Church Letter it was agreed not to repair the wall.

A letter was read from the Women's Institute asking that a Public Meeting be called before any action is taken about the school. The Council agreed that a Public Meeting would be called, a letter to that effect to be sent to the President with the hope that the members would attend. Owing to the state of the finances of the Playing Field Committee the Chairman proposed that a letter be sent to the Playing Field Committee asking if they would accept a rate for it.

Mr Longmate proposed that Mr Bankham be asked what benefit the curavans made to the Product of a 1st rate. This was seconded by Mr Sands and carried.

Mr Longmate agreed to see about getting a copy of envelope for

the Village.
A complaint was made from a
council house tenant of Mr Redman
burning bones in his garden.
It was proposed that a letter be

The minutes of the last meeting
were read and signed.

Arising from the minutes it was
stated Mr Redman continues to
burn bones. It was proposed that
a letter be sent to Mr Harrison asking
that the rent collector contact him.
A letter from Blaheny PC was read
asking if the Council would contribute
towards a gift to Mr Harrison
£1 being suggested from each Council
Mrs Longmate proposed and Mr
Sands seconded that the Council
send £1. This was carried.

It was agreed that the Allotment
Forms be filled in.

It was proposed that an envelope
on Development in the Village
be obtained.

A letter from the Treasurer of the
Playing Field was read accepting

the proposal of a 1st rate for the Playing field.

Mr Sutton stated that he had not made enough money from Bingo for coal for the pensioners but would give a party.

The Annual Parish Meeting was fixed for Monday March 20th at 7.30 p.m. to be followed by a Council meeting.
There being no further business the meeting ended at 8.40 p.m.

The Electricity Agreement for the Lamp put at Camping Hill was signed.

Three cheques were signed and approved.

Before vacating the Chair Mr Crafer welcomed Miss Grempier and the return of Mr T. Pearson, and proposed that a letter of thanks be sent to Mr T. Sands.

An apology for absence was received from Mr Longmate.

Mr Luck proposed Miss Grempier as chairman this was seconded by Mr Sutton and carried.

Mr Pearson proposed Mr Crafer as V. Chairman this was seconded by Mr Longmate and carried.

Arising from the minutes it was stated that the Registration of Common Land had not been done. Mr Longmate proposed that it be Registered before July at the County Council.

This was seconded by Mr Luck and carried.

In reply to the County Council's letter that the Street Lighting did not conform to the Standard required for maintenance by the County, Mr Crafer proposed that the County Council

he asked to bring the lighting up to the standard required at no cost to the Parish.

This was seconded by Mr Luck and carried.

A letter arriving from the Annual meeting re Hollow Lane was read. Mr Longmate agreed to see the Road Safety Committee about it. A letter from the Diocesan Board of Finance was read stating if the Council was interested the school could be leased for a period. Mr Luck proposed that the Council lease it for two years at £50 per year. This was seconded by Mr Sutton and carried.

Mr Luck asked if the road work at Wells was the start of a by-pass for the village.

Mr Longmate proposed that the County Council be asked. This was seconded by Mr Luck and carried.

Mr Pearson proposed that W.R.D.C. be asked to put give way signs at Binham Cockthorpe road and at Chowsley corner. This was agreed to. Mr Longmate gave an account of the Sewerage Schemes in the district with ~~Stiffley still well down the list~~. As there was no further business the meeting ended at 9.15 pm.

A Parish Meeting was called on Monday August 14 at 8 pm in the Village Hall.

To discuss the future of the Village School.

Miss Greenyer was in the chair.

Other councillors present were

Mr Crafer, Mr & Mrs Longmate, Mr T. Pearson, Mr Sutton, Mr Luck and the clerk Mrs Parsons.

The Chairman explained that when the meeting was called the Council understood certain documents would be available to the Parish Council to clarify the terms of the Trust which gave the school to the Village. Unfortunately these have not been made available to your Council up to this moment. In these conditions it is felt that your Council cannot recommend that you should proceed with the matter without further information.

Further we understood that the proposed Sellers infer that they do not hold the deeds.

Considerable discussion followed and finally Mr Luck proposed the following motion. - That we defer action until further legal advice has been taken. This was seconded by the Hon Mrs E. Bailey and carried unanimously.

Under any other business the Chairman announced that a survey of Common Land had arisen and the Council will be glad to hear from anyone who can help with knowledge of the local common lands. All information to the Clerk of the Parish Council and the letters must be signed with name and address.

The meeting then ended as the electricity had failed the clerk was unable to state the time of closure.

Arising from the minutes and owing the holiday period no replies had been received from W.R.D.C.

A letter asking for volunteers for Civil Defence was read. As there were trained men in the village it was proposed that a letter be sent to that effect.

It was proposed by Mr Longmate that a letter be sent to the Diocesan Board of Finance asking for the Deeds of the School. This was seconded by Mr Sutton and carried.

It was proposed that Mr G. Pells be asked to clean the path to Gravel Pit and mow Little Hill. for £4.

A complaint that the garden hired by Mr Butler had not been cultivated was made. As there was a waiting list for allotments it was proposed that W.R.D.C. be asked the position. As some of the letters on the War Memorial were missing and the yard needed to be kept clean it was proposed that Wells British Legion be asked to help.

Mr Pearson reported on the Village Hall and agreed to put notices in three shops asking for a caretaker.

An application by Mrs Hannant to hire the allotment her husband had hired was considered. It was agreed that she could hire it but must not sub-let.

Two cheques were signed. As there was no further business the meeting ended at 9.15pm.

The next meeting was fixed for Thursday November 30th at 8pm.

Arising from the minutes a reply from the Lincen Board of Finance stated they had not got the original deeds of the school. After some discussion Miss Greenyer proposed that a letter be sent to the Ministry of Education and one to the M.P. This was seconded by Mr Tuck and carried.

A reply from the Secretary of Wells British Legion was read on a request by the Council for help in keeping the War Memorial Clean. Mr Tuck said a member of the Legion would paint the letters if the stonework was washed. Mrs Longmate proposed that Mrs Mann be asked to do it. This was agreed to. As the entrance to Gravel Pit had been cleared and certain small trees cut down it was proposed that a notice be put in the Post Office if people wished to collect. Mr Pearson stated that the Village Hall had £30 in the bank. As the Parish Council were the Trustees Mrs Longmate proposed that an oil heater be bought at a cost of about £100. Mr Tuck seconded. This was carried.

Mrs Longmate proposed that it be bought on Hire Purchase. This was seconded by Mr Tuck and carried.

Mrs Longmate proposed a vote of thanks to Mr Gidney and Mr Sutton for their help to the Village Hall.

Complaints were made of pigs in Bridge Street and nuisances at the Wells Road Council Houses. It was proposed that a letter be sent to W.R.D.C. Mrs Longmate to explain if needed.

The entrance to Hollow Lane was again discussed. It was proposed that a letter be sent to Mr Rodman asking if he would do anything towards repairing the road. Mr Tuck agreed to see Mr Butler to know what he proposed to do with his garden. As there was no further business the meeting ended at 9.20 pm.

Mr Curson offered a stove to be used in the Village Hall. He was thanked by the Chairman who said the Council was in touch with a firm for an oil fired heater which they might be obliged to buy but would keep that in mind.

A meeting of the Council was held in the Village Hall on Thursday July 18th at 8pm. Those present were Chairman Miss Greenyer Mrs Crafer Mrs & Mrs Longmate Mr Pearson Mr Sutton and Mr Such.

The minutes of the last meeting were read and signed.

Arising from the minutes it was stated that the time switch was wrong in the light on the Church Gnoel. It was proposed that the Electricity Co. be notified.

Correspondence which had passed between the Purchaser of the School the Board of Finance and Mr Gates regarding a right of way to the former school was read by the Chairman, who had also had an interview with Mr Cullingford.

After some discussion it was proposed by Mr Crafer that a letter be sent to Mr Gates recommending that he sells to the Board of Finance a Right of Way for £4000 and that he will be able to make a donation to the Village from the sale. This was seconded by Mr Longmate and carried.
